

RING MEASUREMENT GUIDE



Below are the IT - US measurements with the relative inner diameter and inner circumference expressed in millimeters.

It is therefore possible to measure the finger or inner circumference of a ring you already own and thus obtain the relative measurement.

In order to measure the circumference of your finger, you can use a tape measure and compare the value in milimetres with the table on the previous page

Alternatively, you can use the Alfredo Correnti metro, taking care to follow the guidelines given here.




- Firstly, print the ring measure. It is important to ensure that when printing the sheet, the image ratio is maintained at 100%, so that the measurements are not distorted.
- Then proceed with a test to check whether the dimension has been maintained: you simply measure the following segment with a ruler, making sure it corresponds to the indicated 2.5 cm.

- You can now cut out the tape measure as carefully as possible and open a slot where indicated by the pointer.
- You must now insert the end of the tape measure into the slot and wrap the paper tightly around your finger. The measurement is indicated by the indicator.

The number given corresponds directly to the Italian measurement.

We recommend taking several measurements during the day to ensure that the measurement is not distorted by environmental conditions such as heat and puffiness.





You can obtain the size from a band ring you already own (e.g. a wedding ring).

It is important to ensure that when printing the following sheet, the ratio of the image is maintained at 100% so as not to alter the measurements. To verify this information, simply measure the segment shown here, making sure it corresponds to the 2.5 cm indicated.

Now place your ring on the sheet, taking care that the edges of the image adhere as closely as possible to the inner circumference of the jewel. The number will indicate the corresponding Italian size
